### A Distinguished History

Built in 1892, Soldier's Memorial Hall has always contained a theater known as "The Opera House," and has entertained residents with fine arts, traveling musicals, school and community performances, and even ladies' wrestling! In the 1960s the performance space was needed for city and court administration, and was mostly forgotten. But in 2000 it became possible to reclaim the space for its original purpose. The Franklin Opera House Restoration Committee was formed by a dedicated group of citizens to restore it and manage its stage operations and programming.
